## LEAGUE

1. The P.C.L. will consist of 12 teams and 3 Divisions, (Murderers Row, Frozen Tundra, Black & Blue)
2. All teams will be realigned every 5 years with the next realignment coming in January 2008.
3. A scheduled season of 14 games with each team playing Division teams twice and out of Division teams once.
4. On week 15 the playoffs will start with the Championship games played on week 16.
5. Week 17 is a fun week using the entire line-up in a ranked schedule; \$15.00 for each winner. Week 17 monies will be used to pay for the new CBS site \$130. We have an extra \$40 to put somewhere.

## OWNERS AND ROSTERS

1. Owners will be responsible for all operations of their team and have one vote in all league matters.
2. Owners wanting to sell their team may do so with the approval of the P.C.L.
3. Owners League Entry fees (\$110.00) must be paid by the date of the draft. If not paid by the date of the draft the league will suspend the right to make transactions of any type (Including Starting lineups) until all outstanding fees are paid.
4. Each team will consist of 14 player positions 2 QBs, 4 RBs, 6 RECs (WR or TE), 2 PKs, and 2 team positions DF/STs.
5. The starting lineup will consist of 1 QB, 2 RBs, 3 RECs, 1 PK, and 1 DF/ST.
6. In accordance with the CBS Sportline program the Owners will be responsible for

their lineup each week or the program will automatically use the previous week lineup.

7. All starting players must be declared before their games start or the CBS Sportsline program will not accept the entry.
8. No Owner can start a player that already played.
9. Teams will consist of a fixed roster of 16 positions NO IR.

## DRAFT DAY

---

1. A Serpentine draft order will be used drawing chips for the first round only (This is only for the Owners Present, Done on Payday first NFL Playoff Game) and Give Owners a choice of draft position as they pick the chips.
2. Absent Owners will be given the closest open slot left available on the numbered chips when chosen.
3. The League will purchase a draft board.
4. The draft will be held at JUDS last Sunday in August at 5:30pm.
5. Each Owner should come prepared with their own cheat sheets because Owners have only two minutes to make their choices.
6. If the time limit is starting to be abused a penalty of said team could lose their position and the next team will pick. Said team will then have 30 seconds to make that choice again. This process will repeat until said team chooses.
7. If a team drafts by mistake a player that already been drafted they will forfeit their choice until the end of that round.
8. Owners may Trade Draft Choices from 'Draft order set' until 'Two weeks before the draft'

## FREE AGENTS TRANSACTIONS

---

1. **Note:** Free agents are available on a first-come, first-served basis; they can be picked up at any time. If a player is dropped from a roster and he clears the waiver process without being picked up, he then becomes a free agent, and can be picked up at any time, without having to go through a waivers process
2. The CBS Sportsline program will handle the transactions. They will rank our teams on Monday night ( The most horrible teams getting first **Waiver** choice)
3. ~~All day Tuesday Owners may put in for a Free Agent or Agents and on Tuesday night 9:00pm the CBS Sportsline program will assign all the Free Agents according to the teams rank.~~
4. ~~As the teams acquire the Free Agents they will go to the bottom of the rank. This is a weekly process.~~
5. Tuesday 10:00pm all free agents will be first-come-first-served basis.
6. All dropped players will be held 24 hours after they have been cut.
7. Free Agents that are drafted cost \$1.00 each. This goes to the post league party at JUDS.
8. All Transaction fees are waived until the start of the season.
9. Trades will be activated as soon as both teams notify the Commissioner or Deputy Commissioner.
10. All Trades must be approved by either Commissioner. Any hints of collusion and the trade will be voided.
11. The trading deadline will be the 11th scheduled week.

## INFORMATION

---

1. Each team's starting lineup will determine your score each week. In the event of a tie your reserve roster will be tallied, if still tied the score will remain a tie.
2. Tie-breaking points will not be added to your total points.
3. Individual yards will not be awarded on Special Teams plays. Special Teams are kicking return teams only.
4. On fake kicks all players become offenses players and players that score will get those points.
5. Owners may challenge for errors in their scores to the Commissioner by noon the following Saturday, but remember the CBS Sportsline is the official program and can only be over ruled by the Executive Board.
6. Executive Board = Commissioner and Deputy Commissioner.
7. The PCL BOWL Schedule Best team vs. Wild Card team.

## SCORING RULES

---

### Offense

- 1) All touchdowns = 6 pts
- 2) QB= 1 point for every 20 Total yards
- 3) Bonus of 3pts for 300 yards Passing
- 4) RB= 1 point for every 10 total yards
- 5) Bonus of 3pts for 100 yards Rushing
- 6) Rec= 1 point for every 10 total yards
- 7) Bonus of 3pts for 100 yards Receiving
- 8) 2 Pt conversion Scoring Player(s) = 2 pts
- 9) PK= FG <50 = 3pts, 50+ = 5 pts, Extra point = 1 pt

### Defense

- 1) All touchdowns = 6 pts
- 2) Safety = 2 pts
- 3) Fumble Recovered = 1 pts
- 4) Interception = 1 pts
- 5) QB sack = 1pts
- 6) Blocked Kicks = 1pts

- 7) Defense will drop 1 points for every 7 points they give up, starting with 5 points (Ending with 0 points)
- 8) Defense will drop 1 points for every 100 yards they give up, starting with 5 points (Ending with 0 points)

## PAY SCALE

### SUPER BOWL BRACKET COST \$930

The pay scale for 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> will get \$130 each. The wild card team will get \$110. First round winners will receive an extra \$50. Winning the Championship is another \$330 for a total of \$510 or \$490 for a Wild card Champion

### RED BOWL BRACKET COST \$140

The pay scale for 5<sup>TH</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> will get \$00 each. First round winners will receive an extra \$20. The \$100 will go to the Champion for a total of \$120

### PINK BOWL BRACKET COST \$80

The pay scale for 9<sup>TH</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> will get \$00 each. First round winners will receive an extra \$15. The \$50 will go to the Champion for a total of \$65.
