Article 2

Any waivers request that would cause your roster to exceed the maximum players allowed will be skipped.

Note: Free agents are available on a first-come, first-served basis; they can be picked up at any time. If a player is dropped from a roster and he clears the waiver process without being picked up, he then becomes a free agent, and can be picked up at any time, without having to go through a waivers process.

- 1) Lineup deadline is 5 minutes before gametime for each player.
- 2) Owners may set lineups.
- 3) Transactions will lock five minutes before the first game on Sunday. **Players whose teams play before Sunday will lock for the remainder of the scoring period.**
- 4) Add/drops are handled by a waivers process. The waivers process runs on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. The waiver order resets after each weeks' games. Dropped players remain on waivers for at least 1 day(s).
- 5) Trades must be approved by the commissioner. No trades can be made after the trade deadline of 11:59 PM ET 11/20/07.

Article 3 To pay for the CBS Sportsline program week seventeen will not be used and that money along with the funded program money will be used. The extra money will go for the Champion prize.

Article 4 **All 15 rounds will be DRAFTED. This means that (round 15 players) the extra player can be drafted for at any time.**

LEAGUE

- 1) Owners will be responsible for all operations of their team and have one vote in all league matters.
- 2) Owners wanting to sell their team may do so with the approval of the USA League.
- 3) Franchise fees of \$90.00 will be paid on or before draft day.
- 4) The USA League will consist of 12 teams with 3 divisions, (SUPER, ROSE, and ORANGE)
- 5) A scheduled season will consist of 14 games with each team playing Division teams twice and out of Division teams once.
- 6) On week 15 and 16 the playoffs will be played.
- 7) All teams will be realigned every year according to their ranking.
- 8) AFTER THE FANTASY SUPER BOWL. All Bracket winners will draft last in their group.

FREE AGENTS AND TRANSACTIONS

A serpentine draft will determine your initial roster.
Number Of

- 1) QB on Roster: 2-3
- 2) Number Of RB on Roster: 3-4
- 3) Number Of WR+TE on Roster: 5-6
- 4) Number Of PK on Roster: 2-3
- 5) Number Of Def on Roster: 2-3
- 6) Trade deadline is the 11th week of the NFL season.
- 7) Free Agent players may be selected on a FCFS basis. (\$1.00 each pickup) This fee will be waived until the first game of the season.

Exceptions.

- a) All dropped players will be locked for 1 days for wavier processing, if no Owners submit a claim after 1 days they become free Agents and can be pick up on an FCFS basis.

- b) A weekly waiver listing will be used. Worst-to-First. One wavier pickup sends the Owner to the bottom. First week computer generated order.
- c) Trades once accepted will have to be approved by the Commissioner. (\$1.00 each team per trade)

THE LINEUP

- 1) Total Starters: 8
- 2) Number of Starting QBs: 1
- 3) Number of Starting RBs: 2
- 4) Number of Starting WR+TEs: 3
- 5) Number of Starting PKs: 1
- 6) Number of Starting Defs: 1
- 7) In accordance with the "CBS Sportsline" program the Owners will be responsible for their lineup each week or the program will automatically use the previous week lineup.
- 8) The program will not allow illegal lineups
- 9) All starting players must be declared before their games start or the "CBS Sportsline" program will not accept the entry.
- 10) Roster changes cannot be made to affect games already completed.

INFORMATION

- 1) Each team's starting lineup will determine your score.
- 2) The points that your reserve score will be used as a Tie-Breaker. If the score is still tied the score will remain a tie.
- 3) Tie breaking points will not be added to your total points
- 4) Individual yards will not be awarded on Special Teams plays. Special Teams are kick-return teams only.
- 5) On fake kicks all players become offenses players and players that score will get those points.
- 6) Owners may challenge for errors in their scores to the Commissioner before next

week's game. But remember CBS Sportsline is the official program and can only be over ruled by the Executive Board.

- 7) Executive Board = Commissioners and Deputy Commissioner.

SCORING RULES

Offense

- 1) Touchdowns <10=6pts, <40=9pts, 40+=12pts
- 2) QB= 1 point for every 25 total yards
- 3) RB= 1 point for every 10 total yards
- 4) Rec= 1 point for every 10 total yards
- 5) 2 Pt conversion Scoring Player(s) = 2 pts
- 6) All = Interception = -2 pts
- 7) All = Fumble lost = -2 pts
- 8) PK= FG <50 = 3pts, 50+ = 5 pts, Extra point = 1 pt

Defense

- 1) All touchdowns = 6 pts
- 2) Safety = 2 pts
- 3) Fumble Recovered = 2 pts
- 4) Interception = 2 pts
- 5) QB sack = 1pts
- 6) Defense will drop 2 points for every 7 points they give up, starting with 8 points (Ending with 0 points)
- 7) Defense will drop 2 points for every 50 yards they give up, starting with 12 points (Ending with 0 points)

Executive Ruling All playoff games will be played on week (15) and (16).

PAY SCALE

SUPER BOWL DIVISION BRACKET COST \$790

- 1) 1st, 2nd, 3rd will get \$100 and 4th will get \$90
- 2) First round winners will receive an extra \$50.
- 3) Winning the Championship is another \$300 for a total of \$450 or \$460 for a fourth place Champion.
- 4) All transaction fees over \$60 are added to the Champions total.

ROSE BOWL DIVISION BRACKET COST \$145

- 1) The pay scale for 5TH, 6th, 7th and 8th will get \$15 each.
- 2) First round winners will receive an extra \$10.
- 3) The \$65 will go to the Champion for a total of \$90

ORANGE BOWL DIVISION BRACKET COST \$75

- 1) The pay scale for 9TH, 10th, 11th and 12th will get \$00 each.
- 2) First round winners will receive an extra \$15.
- 3) The \$45 will go to the Champion for a total of \$60.
